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- The venue did not provide recycling, composting, or free water, which served as an opportunity for our team to provide these services.
- Some project members were not well versed in sustainability. Luckily, these members were studying communications and brought their own expertise to the team, which helped us to better engage with attendees.
- Many attendees were not carpooling or public transport, which we used as an opportunity to increase these modes of transportation.
- Event attendees and vendors wanted to get more involved and learn more about sustainability. This presented an opportunity for our team to raise awareness and help create a culture of sustainability among the vendors, venue, and attendees.

- We partnered with Keep Phoenix Beautiful to implement recycling and compost bins at the monthly festivals.
- We used the funds earned from ticket sales to provide free water.
- We posted information about alternative transportation options and created an accessible spreadsheet on the event's facebook page to encourage carpooling.
- We surveyed vendors and attendees to gauge their involvement with sustainability practices.
- We educated project members and attendees about sustainability through engaging activities.
