

## **Our Final Findings:**

- Most students who participated in the survey attended <u>ASU</u>, the only two other schools were <u>NYU</u> and <u>MCC</u>
- Most students who participated in the survey were <u>sustainability majors</u>
- Most students were interested in following a government/public policy career path
- 10 survey respondents had an interest in a <u>Certificate in SRM</u> followed by <u>Zero Waste Business</u>
- The biggest constraints were <u>money and time constraints</u>
- More than <u>80%</u> of respondents heard about GEUS by either a <u>friend, coworker, professor, classmate or through GLS</u>
- Not a single respondent was aware of the GE.US scholarships available
